CODE OF CONDUCT – PARENTS & SPECTATORS

We all have a responsibility to promote high standards of behaviour in the game. Parents have a great influence on children's enjoyment and success in football. Children play football because they first and foremost love the game and it is fun. Remember, children's football is a time for them to develop and learn. We naturally want them to win, but this must not be at all costs. Always play your part by supporting your child and observing the Code of Conduct.

I will:-

- Remember that children play for fun.
- Applaud effort and good play.
- Always respect the match officials' decisions.
- Remain outside the field of play or within the designated spectator area.
- Let the coaches do their jobs and not confuse the players by telling them what to do.
- Encourage my child, and others in the team. If not, refrain from saying anything.
- Praise effort and performance, and not results.
- Encourage the players to respect the opposition, referee, and officials.
- Avoid criticising a player for making a mistake – mistakes are part of learning.
- Never engage in, or tolerate, offensive, insulting, or abusive language or behaviour.
- Develop an appropriate supportive relationship with the coaches and my child based on mutual trust and respect.
- Support the coaches' decisions and discuss any concerns directly with the coaches.
